The Community Safety Division has two main areas of responsibility: Safety and Public Education. In the area of safety, we focus on creating an environment where everyone focuses on safety at all times, both in emergency and non-emergency situations. We have a safety committee which meets at least twice per year to review safety practices and opportunities to improve on safety.

Public education is the second area and is a larger part of our job. A few examples of public education activities include snowmobile safety, ATV safety, boating safety, and baby sitter class. We also provide fire extinguisher training to many area businesses and community groups throughout the year, along with fire safety and emergency medical service talks to various youth and civic groups. We welcome the opportunity to interact with our community and make every effort to meet these requests for service. The fire department hosts an open house during fire prevention week at the fire station and enjoys the opportunity to show the public the department.
