

HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION MINUTES

The Menomonie Historic Preservation Commission held its November, 2014, meeting on November 10, 2014, at 5:00 p.m. at City Hall. Members present: Tim Dotseth, Ryland Erdman. Also present: Brenna Long and Ken Schofield.

The October 13, 2014, minutes of the Historic Preservation Commission meeting were approved.

There was one (1) Certificate of Appropriateness/Sign Approval application presented for consideration.

The Certificate of Appropriateness/Sign Approval application was from Rory Fedderson of Simple Sports at 400 Main Street. The request for Certificate of Appropriateness/Sign Approval was approved unanimously. See attached.

There was a very brief discussion of the bronze plaques on downtown buildings. Mr. Dotseth provided Mr. Schofield with a twelve (12) year old brochure from Erie Landmark Company of Chantilly, Virginia. Mr. Schofield will attempt to contact this company and get an updated brochure and pricing document. If he is able to obtain same, a copy will be forwarded to all Commission members. Additionally, Mr. Dotseth posed the possibility that funeral homes that often order bronze plaques might have a more up-to-date listing of companies and pricing of bronze plaques. He thought that there might also be a possibility of a donation by (a) funeral home(s) concerning plaques possibly to be erected in the downtown.
