Details of Incident:

On June 5, 2015 at approximately 1:12 A.M., the Menomonie Police Department responded to an armed robbery at Super America South, Menomonie, WI. The store clerk stated the masked suspect threatened him with a knife and demanded money. The suspect left the store with an undisclosed amount of money and fled the area on foot. The clerk provided a detailed description of the suspect and video surveillance was obtained.

A neighborhood search was conducted and a person matching the description of the suspect was located walking in the 300 block of 24th Ave. West. The person was found to be in possession of the knife used in the armed robbery, in addition to other evidence linking him to the crime. The suspect was arrested and identified as 37 year old Curtis A. Reed.

Reed is currently being held at the Dunn County Jail. His bond hearing is scheduled for 1:15 P.M. today in Dunn County Circuit Court. Reed is facing felony charges of Armed Robbery, 2nd Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety, Carrying a Concealed Weapon, and misdemeanor charges of Disorderly Conduct, and Resisting an Officer.
