

MENOMONIE BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE
SEPTEMBER 22, 2014

The Menomonie Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee met on September 22, 2014 at 6:00PM. Committee members in attendance included: Don Kuether, Mark Mastalir, and Kate Kramschuster. Also in attendance were Wendy MacDougall, Kent Conklin, Joan Friedenfels, Wendy Sander, Charlie Jones and Randy Eide. Kuether called the meeting to order. Minutes from the July 2014 meeting were approved.

The in-depth analysis on the Bicycle Friendly Community Application was reviewed. The Committee requested Cedar Corporation take a look at the analysis and provide a "road map" of items the Committee needs to work on to start making our way toward a "Silver" designation.

Eide informed the Committee on the status of bicycle and pedestrian related projects. The B-Cycle proposal was reviewed.

Cedar Corporation will review the property line and easement associated with the Bremmer Bank parking lot corner (proposed bicycle rack location).

Under other Committee concerns the following items were discussed:

- Logger's Loop Markings: Two areas are a bit confusing for users of the loop - crossing Wilson Creek and near Irvington. More markers are needed to get users across Wilson Creek and it is a bit confusing in Irvington as you go from CTY D to the Red Cedar Trail or the scenic road.
- Upgraded bike parking is needed at the Dunn County Government Center.
- Bremer Bank has offered the SW corner of the parking lot on the 500 block of Broadway as a potential location for a new bicycle rack downtown.
- The "Stokke Trail" sign at the Red Cedar Trail needs to be changed to "Junction Trail".
- Sunken bricks near the Red Cedar River Bridge (HWY 25) is posing a hindrance to bicyclists.
- Pedestrian crossing at Stout Rd and 12th Av. A request was made to place pedestrian signs in the road at this location but after further discussion it was concluded the signs may cause more of a safety issue.

The meeting was adjourned. Next meeting is scheduled for Monday, November 24, 2014 at 6:00 pm at City Hall.
