

MENOMONIE BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE
APRIL 25, 2011

The Menomonie Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee met on April 25, 2011. Committee members in attendance included: Logan Mathers, Rory Feddersen, David Williams, Don Kuether and Mark Mastalir.

A motion was made by Mastalir, seconded by Kuether, to approve the March 28, 2011 minutes. Motion carried.

Beilfuss reviewed the East/West Bicycle Corridor plan. Discussion centered around parking restrictions on the southerly route and the need for a safe bicycle/pedestrian crossing on Stout Road.

A motion was made by Mastalir, seconded by Feddersen, to approve the East/West Bicycle Corridor routes as presented with the following conditions:

- No Parking on the southerly route which includes 9th Av (6th St to 11th St), 11th St (9th Av to Main St) and Main St (11th St to 17th St)
- Painted bike lane on southerly route
- Bike signage or "Sharrows" on northerly route (no parking restrictions)
- Establish a controlled bicycle/pedestrian crossing at Stout Rd and 13th Street (possibly a HAWK)

Motion Carried.

Items for the next agenda include Trail Wayward Signage and Other Areas of Concern.

A motion was made by Kuether, seconded by Feddersen, to adjourn. Motion carried. Next meeting is scheduled for May 23, 2011 at 6:00PM at City Hall.
