

## HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION MINUTES

The Menomonie Historic Preservation Commission held its March, 2014, meeting on March 10, 2014, at 5:00 p.m. at City Hall. Members present: Dave Micek, Peggy Terry, Linda Chase, Sue Beety and Monte Burstad. Also present: Joanie Dulin and Ken Schofield.

The December, 2013, minutes of the Historic Preservation Commission meeting were approved.

There was one (1) Certificate of Appropriateness application presented for consideration.

Rick Bygd on behalf of MR Wine Properties requested a Certificate of Appropriateness for both a facade change as well as sign approval for the former Ms.ellaneous building at 320 Main Street. The request for Certificate of Appropriateness was approved unanimously with the following additions to the sign approval: New London Burgundy from Benjamin Moore and Dogwood Blossom from Pittsburgh Paints were the approved colors for the sign.

A lengthy discussion was held concerning the Menomonie Downtown Historic District Walking Tour brochure. The brochure was approved with some minor alterations to be finalized by the end of the week of March 10, 2014. Once the brochure is finalized, West Wind Graphic will print 200 brochures at a cost of \$1,277.00 or \$6.39 per brochure. The Commission approved the cover and back cover language and decided to wait until the April, 2014, meeting to determine how much the brochures will be sold for and by whom.
