

HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION MINUTES

The Menomonie Historic Preservation Commission held its August, 2013, meeting at City Hall on Monday, August 12, 2013, at 5:00 p.m. Members present: Dave Micek, Tom Twohig, Tim Dotseth, Peggy Terry and Linda Chase. Also present: Joanie Dulin and Christina M. Mayer.

It was moved and seconded that the minutes for the July 8, 2013, Commission meetings be approved. The motion passed.

There were five (5) Certificate of Appropriateness applications presented for consideration.

The first application was from Sandra Gilbert on behalf of The Store at 230 Main Street. The application was approved. See attached.

The second and third applications were from Jason Marks on behalf of Broz Tavern at 315 & 321 Main Street. The applications for awning and painting were both denied because of the need to provide the Commission with approved colors from the Historic Color Brochures.

The fourth application was presented by Troy Muntifering on behalf of Kahootz at 336 Main Street. The application was approved with the caveat that if the decal was to be changed, the design must be submitted to the Historic Preservation Commission prior to the changing of that decal.

The final application was from Bob and Heidi Grundvig on behalf of the Noer Building at 400 East Main Street. The application was approved with the suggestion that the upper windows be 2 over 1 as in the historic original photograph, if possible. See attached.

Chairperson Micek indicated that the woman working on the Historic Walking Tour Brochure is planning to have the document completed by the beginning of the school year.
