

MENOMONIE BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE
September 25, 2017

The Menomonie Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee met on September 25, 2017 at 6:00PM. Committee members in attendance included: Dave Williams, Don Kuether, Mark Mastalir, Kate Kramschuster, and Terese Wentworth. Also in attendance were: Patrick Beilfuss, Jody Hagman, Charlie Jones, Wendy MacDougall, Bob Willow, Laura Donovan (UW Stout), Dick Johnston (Eau Claire Bike Committee) and Randy Eide.

MOTION made by Williams, seconded by Mastalir, to nominate Don Kuether as the meeting chairman. **MOTION** passed.

MOTION made by Williams, seconded by Wentworth, to approve the Committee Minutes from May 22, 2017. **MOTION** passed.

According to Beilfuss the Lake Menomin Loop Signs were ordered but they have not arrived yet. We anticipate receiving them soon. The City Street Department will erect the signs for the 8.3-mile pedestrian/bicycle loop around the lake.

Eide updated the committee on bicycle/pedestrian bridge project across I-94. Lunda has started construction and will have most of the work completed by the end of November, 2017. In the spring of 2018 the bridge will be sealed and the City will extend the asphalt trail to both ends of the bridge. We hope to have the bridge open for use by June 1, 2018. Willow commented the project is much needed but asked if the noise could be avoided in the evening and was not pleased with the project communication.

Beilfuss reviewed the Bicycle Friendly Community application with the Committee. The City needs to file a new application in 2018. The City of Menomonie is currently certified as a Bronze designation.

Hagman informed the group that the State Tourism Director will be in the City on October 19th and she would like to showcase the trails in the City of Menomonie. Hagman will coordinate with Eide regarding the Oct 19th visit.

Other bicycle/pedestrian projects in the City were reviewed.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned by Chairman Kuether. Next meeting is scheduled for November 27, 2017 at 6:00pm.
