

MENOMONIE BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE
January 28, 2019

The Menomonie Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee met on January 28, 2019 at 6:00PM. Committee members in attendance included: Dave Williams, Don Kuether, Kate Kramschuster, and Logan Mather. Also in attendance were: Charlie Jones, Patrick Beilfuss, Lowell Prange, Kate Hearth, Kale Proksch and Randy Eide.

Chairperson Mather called the meeting to order.

Introductions were made.

MOTION made by Kuether, seconded by Williams, to approve September 24, 2018 Meeting Minutes. **MOTION** passed.

Beilfuss reviewed the Report Card from the Bike League showing a how Menomonie scored on their application to move from Bronze Bicycle Friendly Community status to Silver. After several questions it was requested that the item be placed on the March meeting agenda for further review.

City staff reviewed several upcoming projects that have impacts on the pedestrians and bicyclists in the City. Those projects included:

- 5th St West (STH 29 to 21st Ave)
- Rapid Rectangular Flashing Beacons on 2nd St and North Broadway
- Hospital Frontage Rd extension from Red Cedar St to Lookout Rd

Eide also gave a brief history on the efforts of the City to improve pedestrian crossing movements across Stout Rd. The City and WISDOT are applying for a Highway Safety Improvement Project grant to improve the crossings and add bicycle lanes on Stout Rd.

Traffic speed on Stout Rd was brought up as a concern. The Committee elected to agenda Stout Rd Speed as a discussion topic at the March 25, 2019 meeting and invite the Police Chief to attend.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned by Chairman Mather.

Next meeting is scheduled for March 25, 2019 at 6:00pm.
