

MENOMONIE BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE
January 23, 2017

The Menomonie Bicycle/Pedestrian Advisory Committee met on January 23, 2017 at 6:00PM. Committee members in attendance included: Dave Williams, Don Kuether, Logan Mather and Kate Kramschuster. Also in attendance were: Patrick Beilfuss, Chief Eric Atkinson, Leah Hauck, Gary Barnett, Ryland Erdman, Mayor Randy Knaack, Katherine Kaspar, Arthur Kneeland, Wendy MacDougall, and Randy Eide.

Mather called the meeting to order. No meeting was held in November 2016 because of a lack of a quorum.

Project updates by Eide included Stout Rd Sidewalk, Elm Ave and Broadway Intersection status.

Beilfuss updated the Committee on the status of the I-94 Pedestrian Bridge and reviewed the Menomin Lake Loop Trail Sign plan. Committee members brought up a concern with the sidewalk transitions on the Lake Menomin Loop in the Elmwood neighborhood (near Crescent St).

Recreational Parking in the Downtown area in the early morning hours was discussed as a concern. Parking is not allowed in the downtown area until 7am to support overnight snow removal operations creating a conflict for residents that want to park in the downtown area early in the morning to walk or jog in the area. After a good deal of discussion no permanent solution was identified but the Mayor agreed to look at some permanent options. For a temporary solution Administration suggested that early morning downtown visitors park at the parking meters in Lot #1 behind the Chamber office.

Under other items, the 6th St and Crescent pedestrian signals were identified as not working properly. Williams let the Committee know that the Sadistic Century may have a family friendly ride option this year.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned. Next meeting is scheduled for March 27, 2017 at 6:00pm.
