

Minutes of the December 21, 2011 meeting of the Menomonie Police and Fire Commission

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 AM by Commission President Ron Sandfort.

Commissioners Mangin, Peterson, Pierce, Sandfort and Ley were present. Also present was Sandra White.

It was moved by Mangin, seconded by Peterson, to approve the minutes of the December 14, 2011 meeting. Motion Carried.

Sandra White addressed the Commission with several comments. Topics included the time taken to select a Police Chief, alcohol compliance checks, and residence requirements for city employees. She left at 10:20 AM.

It was moved by Peterson, seconded by Pierce, to enter closed session. Motion carried.

Interim Police Chief Langlois was invited into the closed session at 10:50 AM. He left at 11:15 AM.

It was moved by Pierce, seconded by Mangin, to come out of closed session. Motion carried.

No action was taken in the closed session.

The Police Department Afternoon Shift Rotation Plan was distributed to the Commissioners for their information.

It was moved by Pierce, seconded by Peterson, to accept Steve Hebbe's withdrawal from the offer of Police Chief made by the City of Menomonie. Motion carried unanimously.

The Commission endorses the continuation of Chris Langlois as Interim Police Chief. The Commission noted that Chris Langlois is fully qualified to be Police Chief except for the residency requirement and is very pleased that he will continue as Interim Police Chief.

The next meeting will occur when necessary.

It was moved by Peterson, seconded by Pierce, that the meeting adjourn. Motion carried.

The meeting adjourned at 11:35 AM.
