There was one Certificate of Appropriateness/Sign Approval application presented for consideration.


The application was from Tammy Wood-Garr on behalf of the Foster Closet at 326 Main Street (the old Simple Sports building). The Commission approved the Certificate of Appropriateness/Sign Approval. See attached.

Ms. Long provided more information to the Commission regarding the application of Menomonie's Main Street Program to become part of the Wisconsin Economic Development Commission's State Main Street Program. The application was recently submitted and there will be a presentation in May in Madison concerning the application. A determination of whether or not Menomonie will be successful in the application will be known on or before July 1, 2015.

Ms. Long also provided information concerning the 125th anniversary the Mabel Tainter. In addition to highlighting the Mabel Tainter's anniversary, other downtown historic buildings will be highlighted in Menomonie. Specifically, Ms. Long spoke about the "We Speak" program where the history of various downtown buildings will be presented in a number of unique ways.
