

## **HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION MINUTES**

The Menomonie Historic Preservation Commission held its May, 2014, meeting on May 12, 2014, at 5:00 p.m. at City Hall. Members present: Dave Micek, Tom Twohig, Linda Chase, Peggy Terry, Monte Burstad and Ryland Erdman. Also present: Joanie Dulin, Ken Schofield and Melissa Kneeland.

The April, 2014, minutes of the Historic Preservation Commission meeting were approved.

There were two (2) Certificate of Appropriateness applications presented for consideration.

The first application was from MR Wine Properties, LLC for 320 Main Street. This application was for slight modifications to the previously-issued Certificate of Appropriateness granted at the March 10, 2014 Commission meeting. The request for Certificate of Appropriateness was approved unanimously. See attached.

The second application was from Hundredth Monkey Maker (Rebecca Kilde) at 129 Main Street. This application is a follow-up request from the original request for Certificate of Appropriateness which was approved at the December 9, 2013 Commission meeting. The request for Certificate of Appropriateness was approved unanimously. See attached.

A discussion was held concerning the Menomonie Downtown Historic District Walking Tour brochure. The brochure was modified since the last meeting. There are still a couple of matters to be finalized in the coming weeks. A final decision on how much the brochures will be sold for will be decided at the June, 2014 Commission meeting. It was determined that the brochures will be sold, initially, at the Chamber office only. There may be an expansion to other locales for the sale of the brochure.

Melissa Kneeland briefly commented on her position with Wilson Place and the plan to reopen the Wilson Place for a variety of events and activities.
