

HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION MINUTES

The Menomonie Historic Preservation Commission held its May 2013, meeting at City Hall on Monday, May 13, 2013, at 5:00 p.m. Members present: Dave Micek, Tim Dotseth and Sue Beety. Also present: Joanie Dulin and Kenneth E. Schofield.

It was moved and seconded that the minutes for the April 8, 2013, meeting be approved. The motion passed.

There was four (4) Certificate of Appropriateness applications presented for consideration to the Commission.

The first two applications were presented by Joan Navarre of Triangle Art and Antiques at 333-335 Main Street. The applications for the Certificate of Appropriateness were approved. See attached.

An application was presented by Monte Burstad for Burstad Insurance Agency at 420 Main Street. The application for the Certificate of Appropriateness was approved. See attached.

An application was presented by Levi Nelson for his building at 313 Main Street. The application for the certificate of appropriateness was approved. See attached.

Joanie Dulin presented some thoughts for painting of power boxes in the downtown. She has contacted Randy Eide, City of Menomonie Public Works Director, Bruce Heath, Street Superintendent, and Lowell Prange, City Administrator, for their input on this proposed mural art project. This matter will be brought back before the Historic Preservation Commission after Summer Daze.

Ms. Dulin was asked about the possible replacement of the mural on the 2nd Street East side of the Medicine Shoppe building (Lee building). A discussion was had concerning the use of paint on brick. This matter may be brought before the Historic Preservation Commission for consideration at some point in the future.

Mr. Micek indicated that he was working to obtain individuals to edit the Downtown Historic Walking Tour Brochure. He will report back as soon as the appropriate person has been lined up.
